Good evening, Jim.

We had a very productive meeting this afternoon, organized by Dave. Dave will be bringing forward his recommendations to the BoS on December 8, but wanted to give you a preview.

We all agreed that we would like to get started on a number of tasks to prepare the museum basement for serving as a storage facility for the Town:

The "quick-er", relatively low cost tasks:

- "Clean out " the well room. Move RecComm belongings there
- Clear out basement except for two wooden tables, which will be kept and utilized for viewing records
- Rip out and dispose of carpet
- Clean floors and walls with strong anti-mildew/anti-mold type cleaner
- Seal and paint walls and floor
- Install shelving
- Install pallets on which to place file cabinets

It was hoped that the DPW could take care of a number of the above items in the winter months. They already did a few days of clearing out. It would probably take another 3 days for 3 of the crew to finish.

Check condition of sump pump and water alarm and repair/replace as necessary

Quotes for water heater, furnace, de-humidifier unit (I understand that the HistSoc has already allocated funding for the latter). Dave was awaiting quote on furnace


Records

ABRSD Fiber Interconnection Project
Blanchard Memorial School to District Network Core
Project Summary

With the exception of the Blanchard Memorial School, all ABRSD facilities are part of a Fiber-optic Wide Area Network (WAN). This network, made up of both District-owned and Comcast-Provided fiber, provides a critical data link between facilities. Many district services are shared over this data connection including, but not limited to:

- Internet Access
- Student and Staff Document Storage, File Shares, and Backups
- Security Camera Monitoring and Recording (Genetec)
- Library Resources (Destiny)
- School Nursing Data (SNAP)
- Computer Management and Antivirus updates (Altiris/Sophos)
- Financial Management (Munis)

Currently no fiber connection exists from the ABRSD network to the Blanchard Memorial School. Although a site-to-site VPN is in place, it is not robust or reliable enough for normal or long-term operations. As a result, many systems do not operate properly or to their full potential. Security Cameras, for example, cannot be streamed at full resolution to the district's Security Operations Center which has a direct impact on our school safety procedures.

ABRSD is proposing the installation of a new fiber-optic link between the ABRSD Network Core (Located at RJ Grey Junior High) and the Blanchard Memorial School. This aerial cable run would be approximately 3.0 miles in length (1.7 Miles in Acton, 1.3 Miles in Boxborough) and would be installed on utility poles along route 111. Physically, the link would consist of 12 strands of single mode fiber to provide plenty of capacity for future upgrades or bandwidth needs. ABRSD has selected Commtract Corporation (Based in Boxborough) to install this cabling and provide project management and support. Commtract is a state-approved vendor with a history of installing similar municipal wide-area networks. They will adhere to all applicable codes, regulations, and standards relative to this type of work and are fully insured for their operations.

Acton and Boxborough both have rights to attach cabling for municipal purpose to the utility poles in their respective towns at no charge under their existing "municipal rights." These rights are granted to the towns during the petition process when the utility carriers apply to place poles on town property. It is essentially a "quid pro quo" agreement between the carrier placing the pole and the municipality. ABRSD plans to attach to the poles under each town's municipal rights and seeks approval to do so.

ORDER FOR CABLE LOCATIONS

That **ACTON-BOXBOROUGH REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT** be and it is hereby granted a location for and permission to erect and maintain cable(s) together with guys and other sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Company may deem necessary, in the public way or ways hereinafter referred to, as requested in petition of said Company dated the 13th day of November, 2014.

The following are the public ways or parts of ways along which the cable above referred to may be erected:

Massachusetts Avenue (Route 111) -

Place one new fiber optic aerial cable (0.6 inch diameter) within the Municipal Space on the poles granted to the Town of Boxborough by the pole owners, said poles running westerly along Massachusetts Avenue a distance of approximately 4,851 feet, beginning at the Boxborough/Acton town line to the Blanchard Memorial School, as requested by **ACTON-BOXBOROUGH REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT** in the Petition for Cable Locations, dated November 13, 2014, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, along with Sketch Nos. TSK- 06 – 09, inclusive.

One (1) New Fiber Optic Cable

Said cable(s) shall be of a diameter as described above. It shall be attached to the poles as detailed on attached Sketch Nos. TSK-06-09, "Towns of Acton-Boxborough Fiber Optic Project", dated October 21, 2014, prepared by The Skyline Group, Inc., 10 River Road, Suite 103, Uxbridge, MA 01569 on behalf of Comm-Tract. All attachments shall be made at a height of eighteen feet (18') at all road crossings and not less than thirteen feet (13') parallel to the road and 15 feet (15') at all driveways, alleys and parking lots as recommended by the National Electrical Safety Code. Note: 18' height at road crossings exceeds NESC codes by 3 feet.

THIS ORDER SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE ATTACHED ORDER OF CONDITIONS.

2. Installation of the cable pursuant to this Order shall be further subject to and conditional upon the execution of that License Agreement between the Town of Boxborough and the **ACTON-BOXBOROUGH REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT** allowing for installation of the cable within the Town's Municipal Space, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.
3. **ACTON-BOXBOROUGH REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT** shall notify the Boxborough Police Department and Town Administrator's office of the installation schedule, and shall arrange for police details as required by the Chief of Police.

LICENSE AGREEMENT

This LICENSE AGREEMENT (this "License") is executed this ____ day of _____, 2014 by and between the **Town of Boxborough**, acting by and through its Board of Selectmen (the "Town"), and the **Acton-Boxborough Regional School District**, a Massachusetts regional school district acting by and through its duly authorized Superintendent, with a mailing address of 16 Charter Road, Acton, Massachusetts 01720 (the "District").

WHEREAS, the Town is the holder of a right to install and maintain telecommunications wires for municipal purposes within a designated space on certain poles located within the layout of Massachusetts Avenue, a public way of the Town (the "Municipal Space"), which poles are owned by one or more companies authorized under G.L. c.166, §21 to erect and maintain such poles for the transmission of intelligence or electricity (the "Pole Owners"); and

WHEREAS, the District desires to erect and maintain a telecommunications line for its use within the Municipal Space pursuant to such permission the Pole Owners may grant, and for that purpose has submitted a petition to the Town under G.L. c.166, §22 to provide for such location (the "Petition"), which Petition is incorporated herein and attached hereto as Exhibit A;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the Town hereby grants to the District the non-exclusive right to enter and use the Municipal Space as duly authorized by the Pole Owners, subject to the following terms and conditions:

Permitted Use: Installing, using, inspecting, maintaining, and repairing an aerial fiber optic communications cable, and related appurtenances, in the Municipal Space.

Term of License: This License shall remain in effect for such time as the District maintains the requisite approvals, permits and licenses required to undertake the Permitted Use, as further defined herein, or until otherwise terminated in accordance with the terms herein.

2. RIGHTS APPURTENANT

The District shall have, as appurtenant to the License hereby granted, the non-exclusive use, in common with others entitled thereto, of the Municipal Space for the period of this License and only for the purposes of the Permitted Use defined in Section 1.

3. CONDITION OF PREMISES

The District acknowledges and agrees that it accepts the Municipal Space in “as is” condition for the purpose of this License, and that the Town has made no representation or warranty regarding the fitness of the Municipal Space for the Permitted Use.

4. PERMITS

This agreement and all obligations hereunder are specifically dependent upon the issuance to the District of all approvals, permits and licenses required to undertake the Permitted Use at the Premises in accordance with all applicable laws, regulations and governmental requirements from those governmental agencies having jurisdiction, which approvals, permits and licenses shall include such permission as is needed from the Pole Owners.

5. ALTERATION OF THE PROPERTY

The District shall not make any alterations or improvements within the Municipal Space except to undertake the Permitted Use under this License, and to restore the Municipal Space as closely as practical to its condition prior to the exercise of the District’s rights, immediately after they are disturbed by said Permitted Use.

6. CONDUCT OF LICENSEE

Non-interference with the Town’s Operations

The District shall at all times conduct itself so as not to interfere in any way with the Town’s use of the Municipal Space.

Compliance with Laws

The District shall at all times perform the Permitted Use in accordance with all applicable laws, statutes, ordinances, regulations, permits, licenses, orders and requirements of governmental authorities and the Pole Owners, and with all requirements of its insurance policies.

Repair of Damage

The District shall neither cause nor suffer any waste of the Municipal Space, and shall restore or repair any and all damage to the Municipal Space and the Town’s facilities therein resulting from any act, failure to act or negligence of the District. This obligation shall survive the termination of the License.

Costs of Operations

The District shall be solely responsible for any and all costs, expenses, damages and liabilities associated with the exercise of its rights under this License.

7. RISK OF LOSS

The District agrees that it shall use and occupy the Municipal Space at its own risk, and the Town shall not be liable to the District for any injury or death to persons entering the Municipal Space pursuant to the License, or loss or damage to vehicles, equipment, structures or other personal property of any nature whatsoever of the District, or of anyone claiming by or through any of them, that are brought upon the Municipal Space, except if such injury, death, loss or damages is caused by the willful act or gross negligence of the Town, or its employees, agents, contractors or invitees.

8. INDEMNIFICATION

The District agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Town, to the extent permitted by law, against any claim by any person for any injury or death to persons or loss or damage to or diminution in value of any property relating in any way to the District's exercise of its rights under this license.

9. INSURANCE

The District shall maintain, at its sole cost and expense, comprehensive public liability insurance, including coverage for bodily injury, wrongful death and property damage, in an amount acceptable to the Town and sufficient to support the obligations of the District under the terms of this License to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Town.

The District shall maintain worker's compensation insurance during the construction of any improvements on the Municipal Space, as required by law. The District agrees that any contractor performing work on behalf of the District at the Municipal Space shall carry liability insurance in amounts reasonably satisfactory to the Town, and shall name the Town as an additional insured party.

Failure to obtain and keep in force said insurance, and failure to provide the Town with proof of same upon request, shall automatically terminate this License and any rights granted herein.

10. RIGHTS OF LICENSOR TO ENTER

The Town reserves the right and the District shall permit the Town and its employees, contractors, agents and invitees to enter upon and use the Municipal Space at any time and for any and all purposes at the Town's sole discretion, provided that the Town's use shall not interfere with the District's Permitted Use.

11. TERMINATION

This License is terminable by the Town following sixty (60) days written notice by certified U.S. Mail, return receipt requested, upon the District's failure to comply with the terms set forth herein. This License shall expire on the date specified in such notice.

12. MISCELLANEOUS

This License may not be modified except in writing, duly executed by both parties.

This License contains the entire agreement of the parties and there are no other agreements or understandings between the parties regarding the subject matter of the License.

If any portion of this License is declared to be illegal, unenforceable or void, then all parties to this License shall be relieved of all obligations under that portion; provided, however, that the remainder of this License shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.

The captions in this License are inserted for convenience of reference only and in no way define, describe or limit the scope or intent of this License or any of the provisions thereof.

This License shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and any and all legal actions brought in connection with this License shall be brought in courts within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
