State Primary: **Thursday, September 8**

August 19: Last day to register to vote and change party enrollment for the state primary. The Town Clerk's office will be open from 9:00am-12:00pm for voter registration. After 12pm, voter registration will continue until 5:00pm at the Boxborough Police Station, 520 Massachusetts Ave.

September 8 (Thursday): State Primary. Polls open at Town Hall from 7:00am – 8:00pm.

Special Election: **Tuesday, September 20**

District-wide Referendum on Bonding for a New Minuteman High School

August 31: Last day to register to vote for the September 20 Special Election. The Town Clerk's office will be open from 9:00am-4:00pm for voter registration. After 4:00pm, voter registration will continue until 8:00pm at the Boxborough Police Station, 520 Massachusetts Ave.

September 20: Special Election. Polls open at Town Hall from **Noon-8:00pm.**

Presidential Election: **Tuesday, November 8**

October 19: Last day to register in order to be able to vote in the State/Presidential Election. The Town Clerk's office will be open from 9:00am-8:00pm on that day.

October 24-November 4: **EARLY VOTING PERIOD**

November 8: State/Presidential Election. Polls open at Town Hall from 7:00am – 8:00pm.

EARLY VOTING

(NEW For November 8, 2016, Presidential Election Only)

Early Voting is open to all voters to make it more convenient to participate in the Presidential Election scheduled for November 8.

- Early Voting will take place at the Boxborough Town Hall, Town Clerk's Office, Monday, October 24, 2016, through Friday, November 4, 2016.

- Hours of Early Voting:

Monday, Oct. 24: 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM

Tuesday, Oct. 25– Thursday, Oct. 27: 8:00AM – 4:00PM

Saturday, October 29: 9:00 AM – Noon

Monday, Oct. 31: 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM

Tuesday, Nov. 1 – Thursday, Nov. 3: 8:00AM – 4:00PM

Friday, Nov. 4: 9:00 AM – Noon

ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee voting will also be available for those who will be out of town on November 8. The deadline for absentee voting is Monday, November 7, at noon. Other instances for absentee voting are as follows:

- A registered voter with a physical disability
- Religious belief; OR
- A non-registered voter who is absent from the state; or
- An active member of the armed forces or merchant marines, their spouse or dependent, or
- A person confined in a correctional facility or a jail, except if by reason of felony conviction.
